

Modifying the dieline ink name

You can use the `DefaultUser.properties` file to modify the dieline ink name that appears by default in a separation in the PDF file as a dieline.

By default, Pandora will append the die file name to the die spot color name when you output PDF or a Prinergy job ticket with the dieline embedded. If you prefer this not to happen, perform the following actions:

1. Exit the Pandora software.
Note: You cannot update `DefaultUser.properties` if the Pandora software is running.
2. Using a text editing program, open the `DefaultUser.properties` file (in the `Pandora version` folder).
3. Type `Print.AppendDieFilenameToDieSpotName=False`.
4. Save and close the file.
5. Start the Pandora software.

To change the dieline name to be something other than `Dieline`, perform the following actions:

1. Exit the Pandora software.
Note: You cannot update `DefaultUser.properties` if the Pandora software is running.
2. Using a text editing program, open the `DefaultUser.properties` file (in the `Pandora version` folder).
3. Type `Print.DieSpotName=new name`.
4. Save and close the file.
5. Start the Pandora software.
