

# Breaking a line between two defined items

You can break a line between two defined items to adjust any part of a line that is improperly designated. For example, you can follow this procedure to identify part of a line as a crease instead of a cut.

1. In the **Input file** pane, select your item from the **Current Item** list.
2. Select the **Line** tab.
3. Select the line that you need to adjust.  
Identify the line based on its designation (crease or cut).
4. From the drop-down list next to the **Set** button, select **Crease** or **Cut**.
5. Click **Editing**.
6. Click the same line again, then use Shift-Click to break the line. (This will let you select the part of the line that needs to be identified as the opposite of the setting you chose in step 4.)  
The line will show a missing segment. This is the part that you will change.
7. Click **Stop Editing**.
8. Join the line segments that have a portion missing between them:
  - a. In the **Input file** pane, in the **Current Item** list, select the item.
  - b. Select the **Line** tab.
  - c. Select two line items that you want to connect.
  - d. Click **Join Segments**.
