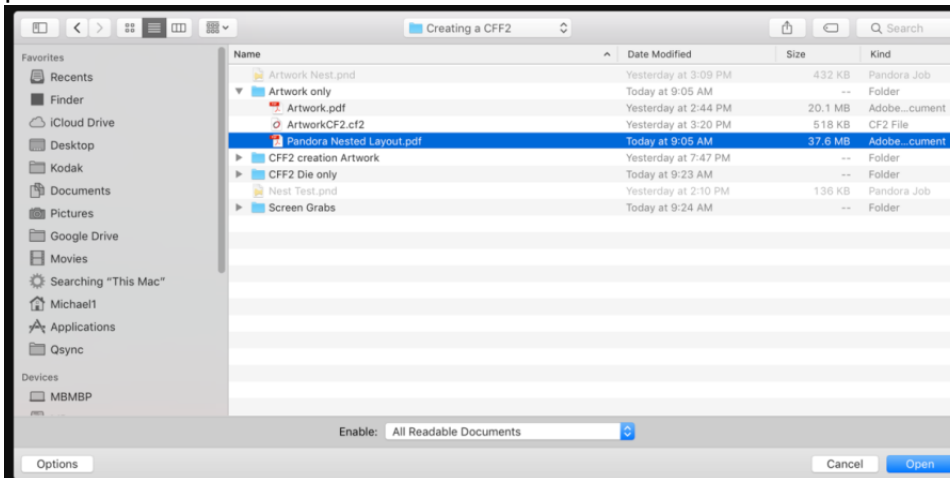
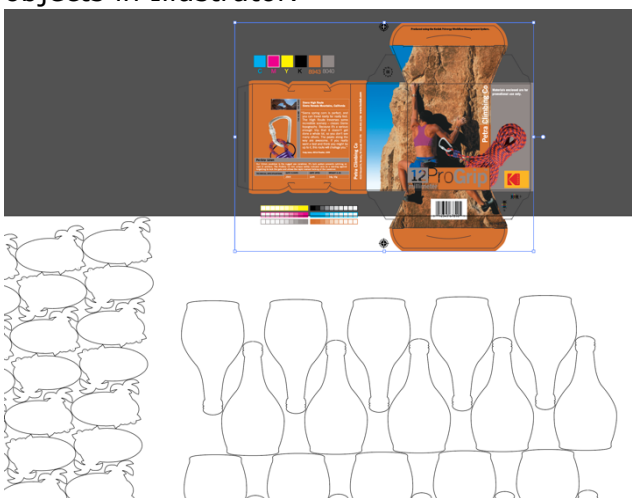


In Adobe Illustrator, save the PDF file as an EPS file

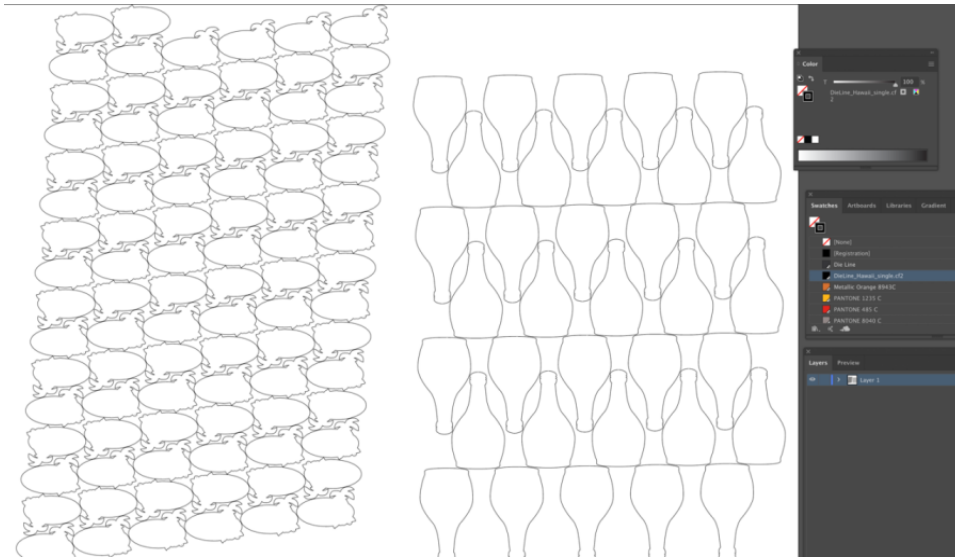
1. Launch Adobe Illustrator software and open the Pandora PDF file that you saved in the previous section.



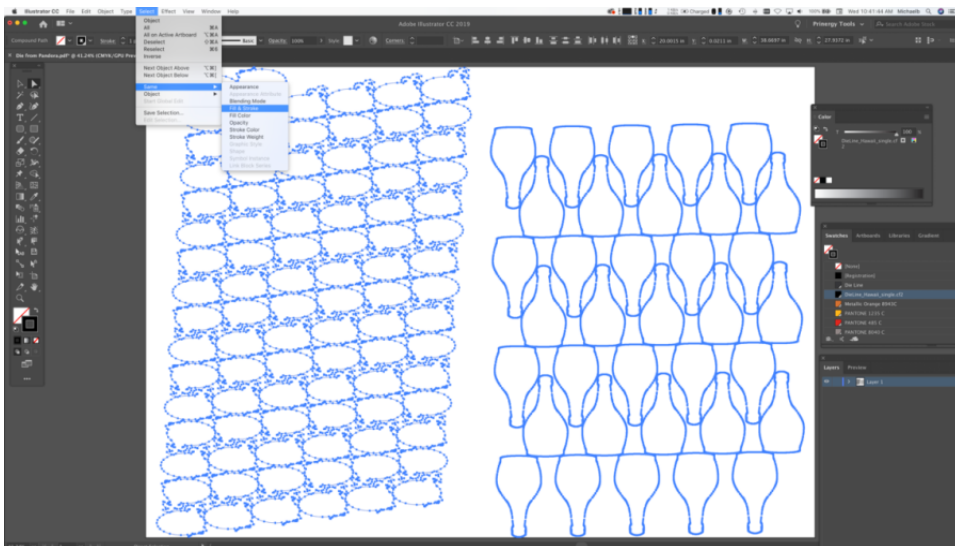
2. Select the artwork added to the file and then delete it. This will leave only the Dieline objects in Illustrator.



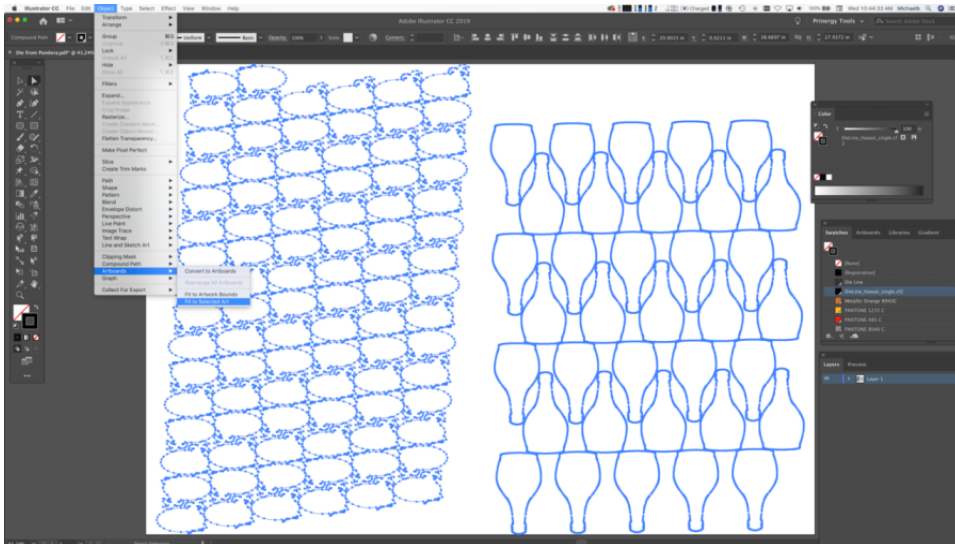
3. From the Swatches palette, select the cf2 color. **Note:** Based on your file, the *Dieline* color may have a different name.



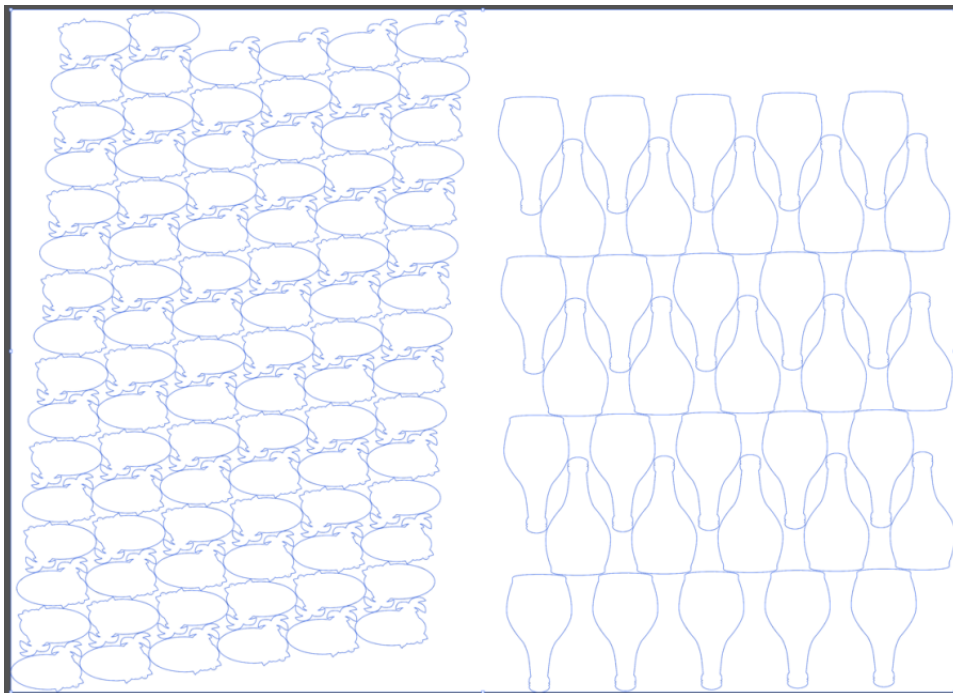
4. To select all objects painted in the *Dieline* color, from the Illustrator **Select** menu, select **Same > Stroke & Fill Color**.



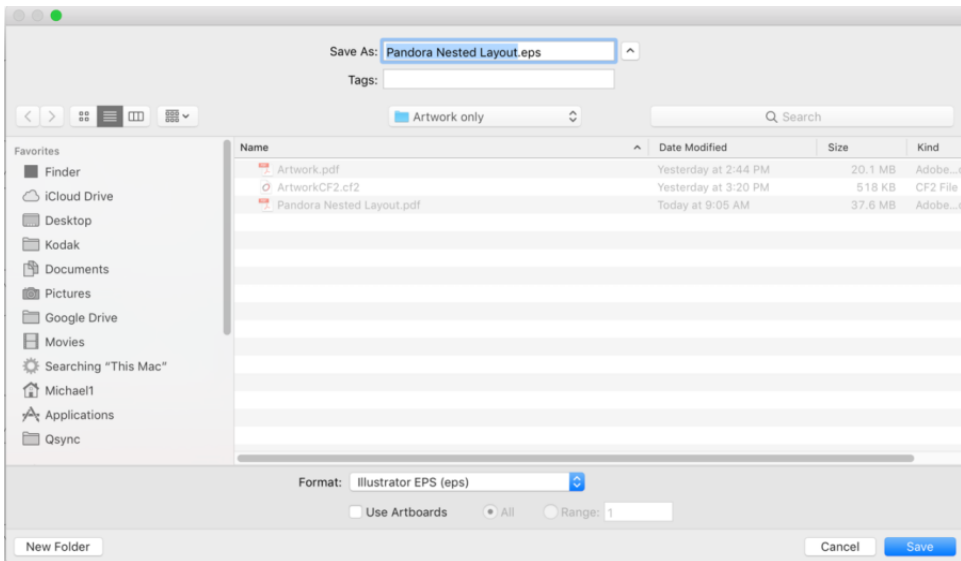
5. To fit the artboard to the Dieline, from the **Object** menu, select **Artboards > Fit to Selected Art**.



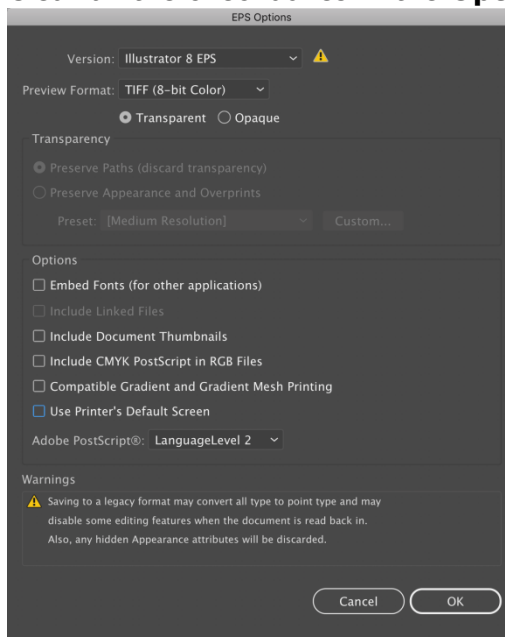
The result should look like this:



6. From the **File** menu, select **Save As**, and from the **Format** list select **Illustrator EPS (eps)**.



7. In the EPS Options dialog:
 - a. From the **Version** list, select **Illustrator 8 EPS**.
 - b. Clear all the checkboxes in the **Options** area.



8. Close Illustrator.
