

Aligning objects using the Geometry palette

1. Click the first object to select it.
2. On the **Geometry** palette, click a reference point on the side where you want the two objects to touch (for example, the lower-right corner).
3. If you want to move the object, type new coordinates in the **X** and **Y** boxes. (If you don't want to move the object, note the coordinates in the **X** and **Y** boxes.)
4. Click the second object to select it.
5. On the **Geometry** palette, click the reference point that you want to touch the reference point on the first object. (In the example in step 2, you would select the lower-left corner.)
6. In the **X** and **Y** boxes, type the coordinates you noted from the first object, or increase the numbers slightly to allow a small amount of space between the two objects.
7. Press Enter.
