

# Resizing the trim box

The Pandora software lets you resize the trim box of artwork, and then offset or center the artwork within the new trim box.

In integrated mode, when you reuse an existing layout and replace artwork with a different sized artwork, you can swap the artwork and use Pandora to shift the new artwork to fit.

1. Select an artwork in the **layout** view.
2. Click the **Ruler** tool and measure the area on the artwork to which you want to set the trim.

The values appear in the bar at the bottom of the **layout** view.)

**Tip:** When measuring in the **layout** view, select **High Res Preview** to provide an accurate image.

3. In the **Attributes** pane, click the **Size and offset** arrow.
4. In the **New size** boxes, type the horizontal and vertical values for the trim box.
5. Click **center**.
6. Measure from the new trim box edge (indicated by a black dot) to the edge of the artwork. The values appear in the bar at the bottom of the **layout** view.
7. In the **Offset** boxes, type a new horizontal and vertical size for the offset.
8. Click **Apply**.

When you resize the trim box, the software maintains any existing bleed paths, because you modified the path to resolve bleed overlaps.
